Directions from 183 Southbound

From 183 South...turn left onto Thompson Lane at the 2nd traffic light after you cross the Colorado River. Callahan's and a gas station will also be on the left. Take Thompson Lane until it dead ends into Hergotz Lane. Turn right onto Hergotz Lane and continue for a couple of miles until the road makes a sharp left hand turn....after going around the curve continue for about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile and turn right onto Hergotz Lane (there is a dump truck parking lot on the left). The farm is located at the end of the road on the right hand side.

Directions from Ben White/Hwy 71

Heading towards the Airport on Hwy 71...once you cross 183 make a U-turn the first stoplight at Thornberry Road. Go $\frac{1}{2}$ mile back on Hwy 71 to Old Bastrop Hwy. Turn right, go 1/10 of a mile and turn right onto Dalton Lane. Take Dalton Lane 1.4 miles down until it dead ends into Hergotz Lane. Turn right onto Hergotz Lane, and continue for a few hundred feet until the road makes a sharp left hand turn....after going around the curve continue for about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile and turn right onto Hergotz Lane (there is a dump truck parking lot on the left). The farm is located at the end of the road on the right hand side.
